

In January 2016, after a three month pilot phase, the Danube-Networkers started the project

„Tastes of Danube.Bread.Wine.Herbs“,

which welcomes civil society organizations active in the areas of education, culture, social and environmental fields, higher education colleges and schools to join the project. Right now, 11 countries of the Danube Region participate.

We want to connect to the success of the previous project “The Wanted Danube” and the resulting huge motivation of the participating organizations and private persons, in order to strengthen the ties of friendship along the Danube through common action.

To start with, the project is planned to last one year, until July 2016, the focus lies on the theme “Bread”.

In their countries, the partner build groups on local and regional level and have different activities, e.g. baking bread, researching various forms of bread use and religious and cultural bread and wine traditions, creating a herb garden, writing lyrics, participating in a photo contest.

The results will provide an insight into the different facets of everyday culture.

Danube-Bread on Tour

In March 2016 the activity “Danube Bread on Tour” will start. This means that we will be producing a “primal bread dough”, which will be parted and shared again and again. The dough will be taken along the Danube river and through the Danube Region countries by bike, by foot, by car or plane and will reach cities and communities. There, people are going to bake bread out of this dough with their individual ingredients and share it with others in their region or a place as a sign of friendship. All people of different ages, ethnic origins and social situations, will be invited to bake and share the Danube Bread.

The base of the "primal bread dough" will be increased with feeding ingredients, stays therefore stable and can be shared as often as required to groups or single persons, who will bake their bread, too.

Pictures of every single activity and the baking recipes will be put onto a website. This way, we shall be able to see how many people will appreciate the idea of sharing bread as a symbolic act.


