I worked more than twenty years on the different fields of cultural life. During this time I recognized and experienced the importance of the local communities and civil organizations, their participation in the European mobility. Accordingly I have undertaken the making application and implementing the EU-projects eight years ago in the 13th district of Budapest, later the coordination of programs and training of the NGO-s. (There're ninety organizations in the district) Since 2009 I'm general-manager of the Civil Days and Street of NGO-s on the out door- gatherings, the European Fest of Neighborhood.

I was the local coordinator of the Grundtvig LP-project Danube Stories involving the aging members of local NGO-s and educational institutes with six European cities together. I had two projects in the Europe for Citizens, Thematic Networking of Twinned Towns: we started 2009 with the Let's Plan and Act Together in order to join the acting citizens of the twinned towns. We finished two years ago the first part of the Green Club Networking project where the children and adults of the cities set long-term cooperation going in the fields of environmental protection.

I dealt with the European Volunteer Service (EVS) also in the last years sending and hosting young people to/from Europe.

We send and host also professional cultural experts through the project BECC.

In my free time –there is not so much – I'm together with my family: I have two daughters who finished just now their studies in the middle schools and search their way in the life. In addition I have a little son who is six old years, I spend with him much of my free time.

Besides I take part in the local public life, read historical books and I am active in more sports.
